

#### IN THE SPOTLIGHT | CHARLOTTE JACKSON



CHARLOTTE JACKSON Deputy Director, Family and MWR

n May of 1978, Jimmy Carter was president, the Women's Army Corps was abolished, 30 million Americans tuned into the first episode of Dallas, and 17-year-old Charlotte Jackson began her career as a clerk typist with Fort Benning's Installation Club Management Division in Building 35. Having graduated at 16 from Carver High School in Columbus, Jackson already had a robust resume by today's standards, with professional experience in shoe sales, child care and bagging groceries at the commissary.

Jackson is the fourth of five children born to a career artillery Soldier and his German bride who raised their family between Germany and Fort Benning, back and forth, until he retired as a first sergeant and went to work for MWR as a printer. Jackson and her siblings gained a healthy respect for hard work early on.

"I always worked. We all did. Back then, if you wanted a new stereo, you worked all summer and saved to buy it," said Jackson, a professed workaholic who worked her way up through the ranks to second in command at MWR.

Today Jackson looks forward to retirement even as she looks back with satisfaction on a career that spanned four decades at Fort Benning and took her through top positions in Services & Lodging Division and Business Operations before she landed in the number two position. As deputy director, she has seen the evolution of MWR, which is short for the Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation.

Jackson started her career at Fort Benning as a clerk typist in the procurement office and worked her way up to Chief of the Services & Lodging Division, which included Club Services at a time when on post clubs were in their heyday. Aside from the Officers Club, there were clubs on Sandhill and Kelley Hill, a vibrant bar called the Hidden Door, and the very popular NCO Club.

Jackson eventually took charge of all MWR lodging facilities, including those historic Cuartels, and remained there until she accepted the position of chief of Business Operations 20 years ago. In 2012, she was promoted to deputy director of MWR. Jackson said her greatest satisfaction came from overseeing the upgrades and expansions of the MWR resort in Destin, Fl., and Uchee Creek on the Alabama side of Fort Benning and the construction of the 920-room Abrams Hall on Main Post.

"I have had the pleasure of being involved with so many great programs and events, and I've worked with some of the best in the military," she said. "I've made lifelong friends and lifelong memories."

But its family that matters most, Jackson said, and her decision to retire was driven by a desire to spend more time with those she loves most, including her mother and granddaughter, her husband and daughter.

"I realize I could work until I die at my desk, but I want to enjoy them all while I can," Jackson said, and she has no real fear of boredom. Her granddaughter, her garden and a menageries of cats and dogs will keep her busy.

# **CAR BUYING TIPS AND TIDBITS**

A car is often a person's first major purchase and the first that requires financing. There are numerous myths about car buying, some good and some not so good. The following tips will help you avoid rip-offs and decisions that might lead to bad credit.


- Research, research and do more research before you buy. Check out sites like Consumer Reports for reliability ratings, online auto traders to determine market prices, Kelly Blue Book and NADA for the estimated value of the car you want to buy and your current vehicle.
- Sell your current vehicle privately; don't trade it in on the new car. When you sell it on your own, you tend to make more money and it doesn't cloud the negotiation process.
- Pay cash rather than finance. When you finance, you pay more for the privilege of using someone else's money, and that drives up the price of the vehicle. If you must finance, save for a sizable down payment. The less you finance, the better.
- Have your financing approved before you shop. Don't finance at the dealership, which complicates the negotiation process.
- Don't be pressured into signing the purchase agreement or loan paperwork until you are confident you've made a wise, sound decision.


#### **FITNESS TRAIL**



The legacy of the Benning Club is one of history and hospitality. It was originally the Fort Benning Officers' Club when it was founded in 1919. When the facility was built in June 1934, it was considered one of the most modern clubs in the Southeast, with an expansive gallery, separate lounges for men and women, a barber and a beauty shop, billiards room, gymnasium, kitchen and grill, guest quarters on the mezzanine level, servants' quarters onsite for round-the-clock service, a paging system and an inhouse telephone system so guests could order from the grill anywhere in the Club. The Club's first pool and formal gardens were added in 1937, and the Supper Club was added in 1960. The Officers' Club was featured briefly in The Green Berets, a movie starring John Wayne filmed at Fort Benning in 1967.

The "Officers Club" is now the Benning Club, and membership is no longer exclusive. If you're a member of the Fort Benning community, you're a member of the club! And today, with meeting space for events that are intimate or extravagant, with rooms suitable for groups of 40 to 400, the Club remains the center of social events on Fort Benning. You may choose to rent one of our rooms or galleries - or all of our rooms and galleries - for your next special event, or you may attend one of many events we host at the Club every year, including holiday brunches, mother-and-son and father-and-daughter formal balls, concerts and comedy night, receptions and so much more.

The Benning Club's gallery, the Regimental Room, is a popular venue for wedding receptions, military ceremonies, such as promotions and retirements, dances, meetings and more. The Regimental Room has a grand military atmosphere. The Supper Club, which is currently being renovated, is also perfect for large events, without the military décor, making it ideal for receptions, balls and formal dinners.

The Benning Club's Lexington Room serves lunch weekdays 11am-1:30pm. You can order from the menu or enjoy our extensive buffet, which includes a variety of entrees and side dishes, soup and salad bars, a wide choice of delicious fresh desserts, and drinks, all for less than \$10. Be sure to ask for a lunch punch card!

The Club also has smaller meeting spaces, including the Corregidor, Benning and Normandy rooms, with accommodations for an office luncheon, an FRG meeting or drinks with your friends. At the Infantry Bar, or Ibar, we pay homage to the Infantry in a setting that is rich in history and warm pub décor. It feels a lot like your neighborhood bar. The Infantry Bar is open to the public 4-9pm Thursdays, and is available by reservation for private events Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

The Fiddler's Green Pub is our salute to Cavalry Soldiers everywhere, past and present. It is located inside the Club, next to the Lexington Room. The pub is open to the public 4-9pm Fridays and available by reservation for private events Mondays-Thursdays.
