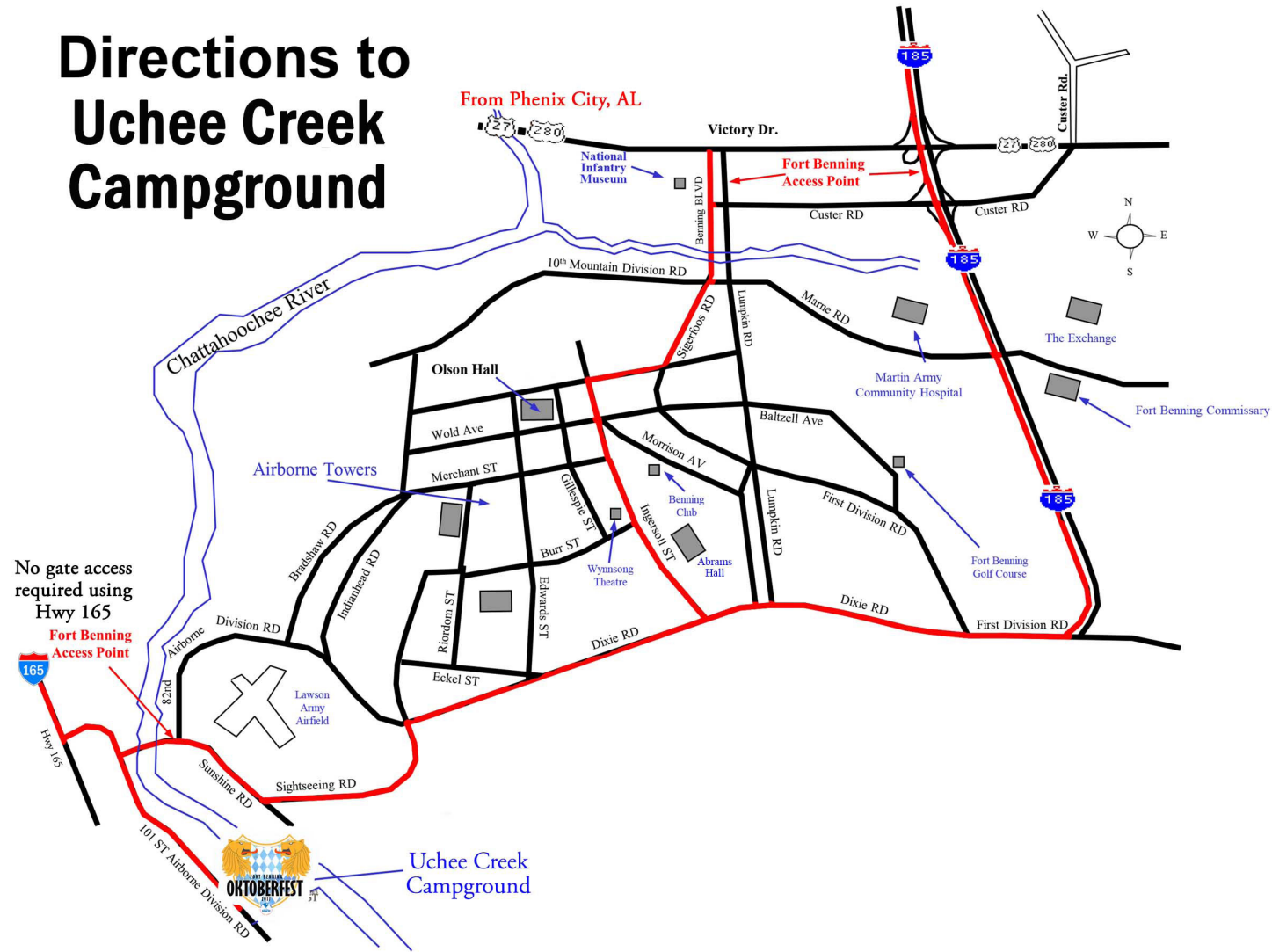

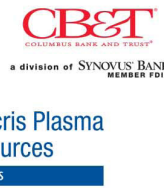


No gate access required using Hwy 165

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

### WHAT IS THE COST?

Admission is \$5 per person per day for guests 18 and older. Younger guests will not be charged admission but must be accompanied by an adult.

Presale of entry wristbands and tokens available during business hours at Building 228, Outdoor Recreation and the Uchee Creek Country Store until October 20 at noon.

### HOW DO I GET THERE?

Take Highway 280/431/80 to Highway 431 South. Turn left on Highway 165 South. Turn left on Airborne Road and follow the signs to the Uchee Creek Activity Center. Drive cautiously; deer are everywhere.

We also offer free shuttle service from select areas around post on Saturday. Pets are not allowed on the shuttle. Go to [benning.armymwr.com](http://benning.armymwr.com) for a schedule and locations nearest you.

### WHERE CAN I PARK?

Free parking is available at Uchee Creek, adjacent to the event grounds.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS?

No guns, knives, or weapons of any kind. No outside alcohol is permitted.

### CAN WE BRING PETS?

Yes this event is dog friendly (only). They must be on a leash at all times (max 6ft length).

### IS THIS EVENT ACCESSIBLE FOR THOSE WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES?

This event is physically accessible to individuals with disabilities. Requests for sign language interpretation or other accommodations should be directed to 706-545-4499.

### WHY DO I NEED TOKENS?

For their safety and convenience, our food and beverage vendors only accept tokens. Purchase tokens weekdays at the MWR HQ, Building 228, 7370 Kilgore Street beginning October 3. You can also purchase them on site, using cash, credit or debit.

### WHAT IF I HAVE TOKENS LEFT AT THE END OF THE NIGHT?

You can return tokens you purchased for a full refund at the token tent/trailer. OR come by MWR HQ, Building 228, 7370 Kilgore Street Monday-Friday and receive a refund. OR save them for the next MWR event.

### WHAT IF IT RAINS?

Grab a beverage and head into the Fest Tent.

### WHERE CAN I BUY A MUG?

At all beer sales locations as well as the Token Refund tent.

### STEIN HOSTING CONTEST RULES?

This event is open to the public, 21 and older, amateurs only. National level competitors are not eligible to participate. MWR employees and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate. Your \$20 registration fee includes a Hofbräu Stein filled with one liter of HB beer.
