In May of 1978, Jimmy Carter was president, the Women’s Army Corps was abolished, 30 million Americans tuned into the first episode of Dallas, and Charlotte Jackson began her career with MWR as a clerk typist. Today, as the Deputy Director, Jackson looks forward to retirement even as she looks back with satisfaction on a career that spanned four decades at Fort Benning and took her through top positions in Lodging, CYS and Business Operations before she landed in the number two position five years ago.

“I have had the pleasure of being involved with so many great programs and events, and I’ve worked with some of the best in the military,” she said. “I’ve made lifelong friends and lifelong memories.”

An Army brat born in Munich, Germany, and raised in Columbus, Jackson said her greatest satisfaction came from overseeing the upgrades and expansions of the MWR resort in Destin, FL., and Uchee Creek on the

Alabama side of Fort Benning and the recent public/private venture that resulted in the 920-room Abrams Hall on Main Post.

The greatest challenge? Ever-changing policies and budgetary restrictions make MWR’s first priority the hardest; meeting the expectations of customers in a community that has come to expect first-class programs and facilities, Jackson said. But the MWR team at Fort Benning will continue to seek innovative ways make it happen.

Aside from work, Jackson enjoys every minute she spends with her mother, her daughter and granddaughter; exploring estate sales and auctions; car shows with her husband; and gardening.




BLENDED RETIREMENT SYSTEM CLASS
