






# How to request your Medical Records

#### <u>Online</u>

- Logon to <u>https://www.tricareonline.com/</u> and Click on the Blue button to access your medical records (You will need to register for Tricareonline.com if you have not done so already)
- Go to <u>https://martin.tricare.mil/Patient-Resources/Patient-Administration/</u>, scroll down to the "Medical Records" section for instructions on how to request a copy of your medical records.

#### In Person

- Present a valid DoD Identification Card
- Complete all highlighted sections on "Release of Information" DD FORM 2870
- Provide current telephone number, address, and e-mail address

\*To Request records for a patient other than yourself, and the patient is over 18 years of age, the following documents are required:

- Patient's DoD Identification Card
- A written consent from the patient, authorizing a third party to act on their behalf. The statement must contain: the third party's
  name and date of birth, patient's original signature, and must be dated by the patient. (Statement is only good for a one time
  authorization)
- Medical Power of Attorney
- If deceased, a copy of the deceased person's Death Certificate.

## NOTE!!!

- Please allow up to 30-45 business days (not to include weekends or holidays) from date of request for us to complete your requested medical records.
- You will receive a courtesy phone call when medical records are ready for pick-up. Failure to pick up your medical records after 15 business days of notification will result in destruction of your records.
- All medical records will be issued on Discs per MEDCOM policy. A fee of \$0.15 per page will apply for another copy of medical records on CD.
- All VA entities have signed a Memorandum of Agreement with MEDCOM to take CDs also.
- By having a CD you will have a permanent copy of your medical records at your disposal.

# Other Health Insurance (OHI)

#### What is Other Health Insurance (OHI)?

- OHI is any health insurance policy that a TRICARE beneficiary may carry which covers medical, dental, pharmacy, etc. established through an employer or private insurance company (excluding TRICARE, TRICARE Supplemental plans, and Medicaid).
- OHI does not limit a beneficiary's access to care, but if he/she intentionally fails to provide OHI information, <u>he/she could be disqualified for health care services from MTFs</u> under 10 U.S.C. 1095, CFR 32, part 220.

#### DD Form 2569

- Beneficiaries must update their OHI information during the registration process annually (or with changes with insurance data).
- Beneficiaries will receive an OHI verification card (good for 12 months) from registration personnel in exchange for completing a new Form DD2569.
- NOTE: A DD Form 2569 is not required for active duty soldiers or newborns.

# Other Health Insurance FAQ's

#### Will Reporting My OHI Negatively Impact My Out of Pocket Expense?

No. According to Title 10 U.S. Code Section 1095, the beneficiary is not subject to copays, coinsurance, or deductibles. "A covered beneficiary may not be required to pay an additional amount to the United States for healthcare services ..."

#### How Does Reporting OHI Benefit You?

 Funds collected through the Third Party Collection Program (TPCP) are used to enhance quality of health care delivery at your treatment facility. Claims filed toward your OHI also help meet your deductible for cases in which you receive medical care in a civilian treatment facility.

#### What is NOT Covered by OHI?

- OHI may not cover subsistence costs related to inpatient care or co-pays for TRICARE services provided downtown.





## **Behavioral Health**

### TRICARE® Telemental Health Services

Through telemedicine, TRICARE beneficiaries can get medically and psychologically necessary services through secure audio and video conferencing from a TRICARE-authorized provider.

#### What is telemental health?

Telemental health allows you to access mental health care in the privacy of your own home because it removes barriers to care based on providers in your geographic location or your inability to travel to a provider. All that's needed is a computer with a webcam and internet access. Your provider will interact with you through secure, HIPAA-compliant software.

Audio-only telephone services are temporarily covered during this stateside public health emergency.

#### A telemental health care provider can address concerns such as:

- Major life stressors
- Emotional distress
- Grief-related counseling
- Work and family issues
- Depression, anxiety and how to cope

#### **Referrals and authorization**

As with any mental health care received from a TRICARE network provider, active duty service members need a referral before getting care under the telemental health care benefit. TRICARE Prime active duty family members and retirees do not need a referral or authorization to set an online care appointment with a distant provider.



The Electronic Health Record

MHS GENESIS, the new electronic health record for the Military Health System, provides enhanced, secure technology to manage your health information.

MHS GENESIS integrates inpatient and outpatient solutions that will connect medical and active duty dental information across the continuum of care, from point of injury to the military treatment facility. This includes garrison, operational, and en route care, increasing efficiencies for beneficiaries and healthcare professionals.

When fully deployed, MHS GENESIS will provide a single health record for service members, veterans, and their families.

#### **Patient Portal Access**

To access the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal, visit https://patientportal.mhsgenesis. health.mil. Beneficiaries can log in to the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal using their DS Logon. Premium Access (Level 2) is required to view the health record.\*

In preparation for the new MHS GENESIS Patient Portal, log in to milConnect and create your DS Logon. Beneficiaries with an existing DS Logon should upgrade their account to Premium Access. A link to the "My Access Center" is available via the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal landing page to direct patients on obtaining their DS Logon credentials.


