Deadline for Scholarships for Military Children is Feb. 15

The Fisher House Foundation's Scholarships for Military Children Program is now accepting applications for the 2019 - 2020 school year. The deadline for students to submit online is Feb. 15. This marks the first time the entry process will happen entirely online. "It will be simple to create an account, save your work and submit your application when finalized," said Jim Weiskopf, vice president, Fisher House Foundation, the nonprofit organization that administers the program. "The online process will make it easier for military children to reach their education goals." Eligibility for the program is determined using the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System database. Applicants should ensure that they, as well as their sponsor, are enrolled in the DEERS database and have a current military dependent ID card. All rules and requirements for the program, as well as links to frequently asked questions are available at the <u>Scholarships for Military Children</u> website.


