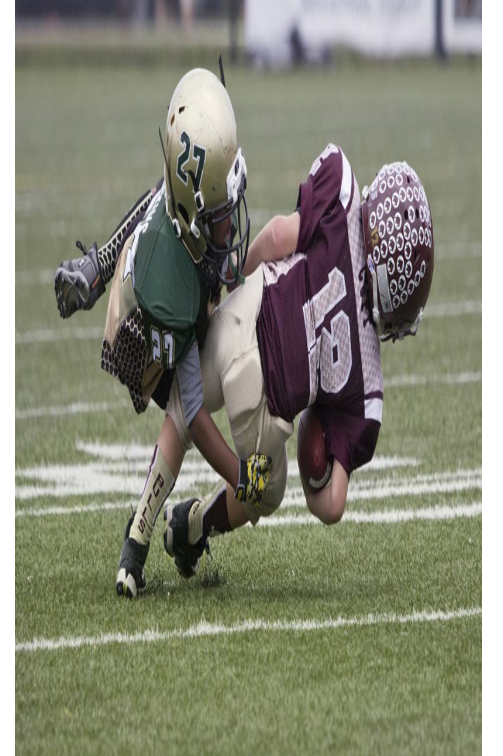

NAF GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS



BEFORE YOU APPLY

___ Have you previously worked for Army NAF?

___ Was your resignation date within the last 3 years?

Did you answer "YES" to both of the questions above? Then..... CONGRATULATIONS!!

You may be eligible for non-competitive reinstatement into the same or equivalent position in grade, or one with a lower rate of pay. If interested contact your local NAF HR Office for more information.

PLAN AHEAD

1. Create your Login.Gov Account

A Login.Gov account is needed to apply for all Army NAF positions. You will need to create a Login.Gov account if you don't already have one. Within www.usajobs.gov click on "[Create a Login.Gov Account](#)" and then follow the instructions.

2. Prepare your Application Package In Advance

Your application package includes your resume, responses to the occupational questionnaire and supporting documents. You can preposition some of these items in your USAJOBS account to save time when you want to apply to a specific vacancy announcement.

3. Create/Save Job Searches

Create and save job searches for the types of positions that you frequently seek. Request automatic email up-dates for positions that match your search criteria maximizing your awareness of job opportunities. You can create and save up to 10 different "saved searches."

4. Make your resume 'Searchable'

Make your resume searchable so your resume will be visible to recruiters and HR professionals.

5. Review Announcement Requirements

To avoid being ineligible, read the announcement in its entirety. There are conditions of employment, how to apply and application requirements addressed in the announcement that must be met.

6. Keep Your Account Updated.

Make sure your account always has your current contact information, especially your email address. Applicant notifications are sent to the email address on record so it is important that any changes in your email address are reflected in your USAJOBS account



NAF GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS



Resume Tips...

Take the time to develop a strong resume.

- ◇ Clearly describe duties and level of experience.
 - ◇ Avoid jargon and acronyms.
 - ◇ Check grammar and spelling.
 - ◇ Include beginning and end dates for each job.
- ◇ Tailor resume content if you have different types of skills and are applying for different types of positions.
- ◇ Review and update resume to reflect current assignment/employment.

- ◇ For questions regarding the position or your application, contact the NAF HR representative listed on the vacancy announcement.
- ◇ Don't have a computer? No problem, there is a manual application process! Contact the NAF HR Office or representative listed as the point of contact on the Vacancy Announcement to obtain a manual application.

Commonly Required Supporting Documents

Military Spouse: Permanent change of Station (PCS) Orders.

Veterans: DD214 (Certificate of Release or discharge from active duty, member –4 copy)

Current or Former Federal Employees: Your most recent (non-award) Notification of Personnel Action (SF50, DA Form 3434).

Other: Diploma, Transcripts, Licenses, and Certificates (CPR, First Aid, AED, VoTech, etc.)

You are able to add other documents required for specific vacancies during the application process.

1. Type "NAF" in the "Keywords" box. Type "Fort Benning" into the "Location" box. Then click "search."

2. Click on the blue job title of the position you would like to apply for to see more information about the job.
3. Read the entire job announcement. Pay close attention to the **Required Documents** section.
4. Click the **Apply** button then sign in or create a new account and then sign in.
5. Follow the steps to create or upload a resume and any other documents you want to include with your application.
6. After selecting all the documents you want to submit with your application, check the ☐ ** I acknowledge that I have reviewed my resume and document(s)* box and then click the **Save & Continue** button.
7. Check this box ☒ *I certify, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all the* **Continue Application with Agency** and click the **Continue to Agency Site** button.
8. On the agency page, click the **Continue** button to start the assessment
9. Fill out the required fields and answer all questions.
10. After you answer all of the questions you will come to a page that lets you link each of your uploaded documents to the appropriate document type AND upload any documents you may have forgotten. **NOTE:** Only documents that are marked **"(required)"** must be linked. Other forms are optional.
11. On the next page, if you have all green check marks, check the acknowledgment box and click the submit application button.

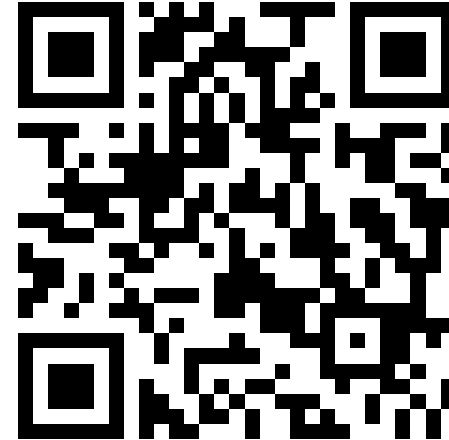

- To ensure our care teams have adequate time to upload your full medical history in the new EHR and properly document the current encounter in the new EHR, we are implementing the following standardized adjustments:
