SUBJECT: Extension of Partial Waiver Temporarily Permitting Child Development Programs (CDPs) to Employ Dependents of Service Members and DoD Civilians

Pursuant to my authority under Department of Defense Directive 5124.10, I am extending the waiver of section 8.e of Enclosure 3 of DoD Instruction 6060.02, "Child Development Programs (CDPs)," first authorized in the attached memorandum of July 8, 2020, "Partial Waiver in Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic Permitting Child Development Programs to Employ Dependents of Service Members and DoD Civilians Who Are 17 Years of Age and Pursuing a High School Diploma."

This waiver permits CDPs to employ dependents of Service members and DoD civilian employees who are at least 17 years of age and pursuing a high school degree. This waiver extension shall remain in effect until June 30, 2021. All requirements contained in the attached July 8, 2020 memorandum shall remain in effect for the duration of this extension.
