This year's campaign seeks to support victims with a clear message: If you are experiencing abuse in your relationship, you don't have to face it alone. Learn about the help your local Family Advocacy Program (FAP) provides and other resources available to you. FAP staff members are always available to support those impacted by domestic abuse, whether they are at a point where they want to leave their partner or are just looking for information. They work with victims to develop a safety plan, and can connect them to emergency services, counseling, emotional support, housing, shelter, financial and legal services. If needed, they can help victims get a military or Civilian protection order.
