COVID-19 Vaccination



- Available during routine or nurse appointments
- Primary series and booster dose:
 - 6 mos. – 4 yrs. primary
 - 5-12 yrs. primary and booster
 - >12 yrs. primary and booster



Wellness Exam

- This exam should take place once a year
- Components of this exam include:
 - Height, weight and BMI
 - Blood pressure, heart rate
 - Listen to your heart and lungs for abnormal sounds
 - Sleeping habits, diet, exercise
 - Stress levels
 - Smoking and alcohol effects on your health
 - Lab Testing
- Time to review other preventative health screenings needed such as vision, hearing, skin cancer screening, foot exams.
- Time to review socioeconomic factors affecting your health such as housing insecurity, food insecurity or difficulty paying bills.



Survey of Well-being of Young Children (SWYC)



- Enhanced comprehensive screening instrument for children under 5 years of age
 - Developmental
 - Autism
 - Emotional/Behavioral
 - Family



Breast Cancer Screening



- 1 out of 8 women will get diagnosed with breast cancer (seeing earlier ages diagnosed with breast cancer)
- 1 out of 100 men will get diagnosed with breast cancer
- MACH offers 3D mammography technology
- Women age 40-74 with no previous history or surgeries can self refer
- Call (762) 408-2079 to schedule – no referral required!



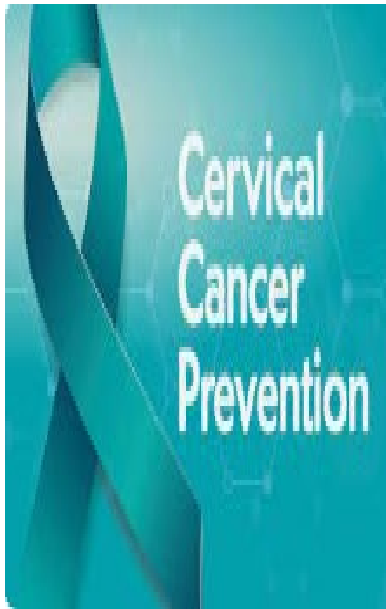
Colon Cancer Screening



- On average lifetime risk is about 1 to 24
- Anyone, any age can be diagnosed with colon cancer
- New screening age of 45
- Types of testing MACH offers
 - Colonoscopy (referral needed from provider)
 - Cologuard screening
 - FITDNA testing
 - Occult stool testing
- Book an appointment to discuss with your provider



Cervical Cancer Screening



- In the U.S each year about 13,000 new cases of cervical cancer are diagnosed and about 4,000 women die of cervical cancer.
- Five main types of GYN Cancers: cervical, ovarian, uterine, vaginal and vulvar. Sixth which is rare is fallopian tube cancer.
- Screening age 21-65.
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV), HIV, and Tobacco use have a role for increased risk factors. Additionally, previous abnormal cervical testing can place you at a higher risk.
- Women between the age of 16-24 who are sexually active and/or prescribed birth control it is recommended for an urine chlamydia test to be done annually.
- Schedule an appointment to discuss with your provider.



Integrated Health Services in Primary Care

- Immunizations – may call to book nurse appointment
- Outpatient Lab
- Behavioral Health – requires referral
- Sports Medicine – requires referral
- Physical Therapy – requires referral
- Nutrition – requires referral
- Clinical Pharmacist – requires referral
- Diabetes Self Management Education Class
 - Referral required for face-to-face or virtual
 - F2F-1st and 2nd Wednesdays of the month
 - Virtual-Thursdays, 2p-4p

 - Ages: 3 mos. and older
