





Body fat: A certain amount of fat is absolutely necessary for good health. Fat plays an important role in protecting internal organs, providing energy, and regulating homomors. The minimal amount of "essertial fat" is approximately 3-5% for men, and 12-15% for women. If too much fat accumulates over time, health may be compromised (see fable below)

Fat Fne Mass: Fat fine mass is everything except fat. It includes muscle, water, bone, and internal organs. Muscle is the "metabolic engine" of the body that bums calories (fat) and plays an important role in maintaining strength and energy. Healthy levels of fat-free mass contribute to physical fifness and may prevent conditions such as osteoporosis.
