At Fort Benning, we celebrate Independence Day a little early around here! Our annual **Independence**Celebration on June 28 provides Soldiers, their families, and our surrounding community a safe environment to enjoy a free concert, children's activities and a fantastic fireworks show!

This year's entertainment includes country duo, **Maddie & Tae**, headlining the free concert on the *Floor & Decor Stage*, and special guest, country artist **Eric Paslay**. **Black Rhino Sound**, the electrifying Texas DJ, will kick off the evening and energize the crowd.

The event will also include a **Kids' Zone** sponsored by Headquarter Nissan, aerial demonstrations by the Silver Wings and a variety of food vendors. The **Maneuver Center of Excellence Band** concludes the evening with a patriotic score choreographed to the *Russell County Commission* fireworks show.

Special guest **Eric Paslay** is a Platinum-selling, Grammy-nominated songwriter, artist and performer. With five number one hits, including his smash lead single "Friday Night," the country artist has earned numerous songwriter award nominations including Grammy's Best Country Song, ACM's Song of the Year (twice) and CMA's Song of the Year.

MADDIE & TAE

Maddie & Tae took country radio by storm in 2013 with a brilliant counter to bro-county, the Platinum-selling smash, "Girl In A Country Song." Longtime friends and collaborators, Maddie & Tae bring honest songwriting and tight harmonies to the stage. In 2022, Maddie & Tae took home Group/Duo Video of the Year ("Woman You Got") at the CMT Music Awards and were nominated for Duo of the Year at the 59th ACM Awards in 2024.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC!

We encourage you to bring your friends and family to the Independence Celebration, but keep in mind that gate access on the 28th will require 100% ID check. Please share with non-cardholding guests planning to drive themselves that they can plan ahead and get prevetted online and pick up their visitor pass at the Visitor Center at Plumley Gate on I-185 until midnight on June 27. Those who do not get pre-vetted must use Grange Gate just past the National Infantry Museum or the Childers Gate off of AL-165 on the 28th.

Be prepared for random vehicle searches.
