

Currently available services include Army Emergency Relief and the Family Advocacy Program's victim advocates.









FAMILY ADVOCACY



During the lapse in appropriations, Family Advocacy Program services are limited to victim advocacy for incidents of domestic violence, child abuse, child neglect, or problematic sexual behavior in children and youth. Previously scheduled awareness events, briefings and trainings are on hold until funding has been reestablished.


