


Mandatory Deer Check

- Georgia Hunters - mandatory check station at NRMB Harmony Church (corner of Rykus Avenue and 1st Division Road) Deer Check/Cleaning Station.
- Alabama Hunters – Due to limited harvesting, shifting data collection to every other year
- Mandatory Deer Check Days
 - Georgia
 - November 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 22, 23
 - Alabama
 - NONE for '25-'26 season

FB 200-1 Changes

- Updated Hunting Dates for AL and GA in Tables 10-1 and 10-2.
- Trail Cameras only allowed in designated hunting areas; only wildlife photos should be disseminated
- Bicycles/eBikes are held to motor vehicle standard (no bypassing locked gates)
- iSportsman Annual User Fee = \$15
 - IMCOM-mandated to cover contract costs
 - Applies to ALL (including honorary)
- Cantonment Archery Program added

FB 200-1 Reminders

- Turkey: Only one (1) gobbler allowed post-wide per season
- Fox Squirrel: One (1) per day, one (1) in possession
- Open Areas are “first come, first served”
- “Trophy” deer jawbone memo
 - Allows hunters two (2) weeks to obtain jawbone from taxidermist & return to NRMB
 - If not returned, can be suspended unless given extension by CLEO or NRMB



Current Issues


- Hunting out of Table 10-2 season dates
- Harassment (Do not approach hunters/ if you observe a problem report it)
- All weapons MUST be registered with IAW MCoE Reg 190-11
- Weapons and Ammunition not being transported IAW MCoE Reg 190-11
- Trail Cameras should only be used in the Woodline for hunting purposes only (DO NOT post images of individuals, training or roadways)
- Hunting in closed areas or exclusion areas


